

Thank you for registering to attend TLC's Museum of Making Music field trip on **Wednesday, January 17, 2018**.

Please check in with TLC staff at **9:30am (Revised)** near the entrance to the museum.

The tour runs 1.5 hours, including:

- Drum circle – an interactive “hands-on” experience where students will learn about music concepts including rhythm, tempo & dynamics.
- S.T.E.A.M. Station (grades 2 and up) – addressing Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts & Math. Students will see how an electric guitar is assembled from start to finish.
- The museum's 5 galleries - highlighting the importance of the Music Products Industry in making, selling and using musical instruments from the late 1800s through present day. Each gallery features a “hands-on” instrument of the era specific to the gallery.
- *Innovation Studio* – gallery featuring all “hands-on” instruments. Students will be able to play guitars, keyboards, ukulele, banjo, electronic drum set, Strumstick, Theremin, Harpsicle & Beamz.
- Also featured in the *Innovation Studio* is our Global Spotlight, a virtual globe that takes you around the world to experience the music of different countries.
